DOROTHY STRINGER SCHOOL JUNIOR PROGRAMME (AGES 5-12)

Programme Start Dates

July: 26, August: 2, 9, 16, End: August 20 2010.

All programmes start dates are Mondays.

Full Junior Programme

£170 per child per week, plus £20 registration fee. Monday -Friday, 09.00 - 16.00.

'Full Junior Programme' price includes:

- English language tuition (15 hours per week - maximum class size 15).
- Teaching materials and course certificate.
- Membership of on site Summer Club - joining local English children after lessons, for arts, sports, games and fun activities.
- Full supervision during school hours.
- Use of school sports facilities (swimming pool, sports hall, basketball courts, tennis courts, playing fields, Dance studio, football pitches, trampolines), art and crafts room, play park.

Supplements:

- Daily return transport to and from school by minibus/taxi (2 mile radius): £75 per week.
- Lunch: £25 per week.
- **Not included:**
- Supervision outside of school hours. Children must be accompanied by parent or guardian.
- Any additional off site excursions/activities.
- Accommodation.
- Personal insurance, airports transfers, one to one tuition - Can be arranged

- Dorothy Stringer High School, Loder Road, Brighton. (in the North of Brighton, near Preston Park on the 5B bus route)

Important Information

- The age range for the programme (5-12) is intended as a general guide only. Suitability of the programme for individual children may vary, and will depend on each child's personal maturity, social and language skills. If parents are unsure if the programme is suitable for their child we are happy to discuss this before booking.
- To help children settle and gain the maximum out of the programme we recommend that they should already possess basic English language skills, as well as a certain amount of confidence to interact with unfamiliar persons in a new environment.
- The programme's aims to develop children's experience of English language and culture through structured lessons as well as play/social interaction with local children.
- BISS offers a teenage programme (ages 13-18) with lessons in the same school, plus excursions and accommodation.
- The junior programme (ages 5-12) is operated by Dorothy Stringer School and is covered by their OFSTED registration and not by the BISS British Council accreditation.
