## SCHOOL CODE

- ✓ You need to attend 80% of the course to get your diploma
- ✓ Be punctual
- ✓ Take an active part in lessons
- ✓ Switch your mobile phones off during class
- ✓ Speak English for as much time as possible
- ✓ No smoking or chewing in school grounds
- ✓ Take care of and respect other people's property
- ✓ Abide by local laws and customs
- ✓ Alcohol and drugs are not tolerated under any circumstances
- ✓ Inform your host family if you intend to be late
- ✓ Inform the school if you are going to be absent
- ✓ Respect other students cultures and religions
- ✓ You must respect your host family and be home for dinner at the correct time. If you are going to be late, or do not require dinner at all, PLEASE tell your family. You can not expect dinner to be kept for you if you arrive home later than the agreed dinner time .(normally between 18.00 - 19.00).
- ✓ You must be home by 10pm; ***there is no exception to this rule.*** In the UK you are still considered a child if you are under 18 (for under 16`s we recommend being home by 9 pm)
- ✓ If you are under the age of 16 you must not leave the Brighton area in your free time unless you are supervised by your group leader or host family or unless you are given permission
- ✓ If you do not abide by the school code or you break the law you may be asked to leave.
